Rector's Letter December 2017 - January 2018



In November I went on a Conference and while there we studied the Gospel of John, a wonderful Gospel full of rich language which begins with the words "In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God and the Word was God" (John 1:1). The Word refers to Jesus and as you will know it is at Christmas that we celebrate Jesus coming to live among us.

As we enter December preparations for Christmas will most probably be at the fore front of our minds. With presents to buy and cards to write; food to organise and plans to be made, the real meaning of Christmas can quite easily get lost. The Christmas card, detailing the various services in the benefice, this year has the words "God with us" on the front and a picture of the holy family in the stable. That is the real meaning of Christmas, that God chose to come among us, as a baby, born in a borrowed stable. And He came, as you will read in the card, to offer us a relationship that changes everything about our past, our present and our future.

To help us to prepare spiritually for Christmas and to remind us that God is with us always, St Mary's church has some special services planned and everyone is welcome to join us.

On Saturday 9th December at 6pm there will be Community Carols at Ecton Play Park. On Sunday 17th December the Christingle service takes place at 10am followed in the evening with the popular Carol Service at 6pm. Tuesday 19th December 1pm - Lunch 2pm, Songs of Praise Ecton.

As Ecton is part of a benefice of three churches it is not always possible to have a service on Christmas Day, however there will be a Communion Service at 10am on Christmas Eve 24th December and Midnight Mass will be at Great Doddington 11,15pm.

On Christmas morning Ecton church will be open between 8.30am and 9.30am for quiet reflection and the opportunity to light a candle and everyone is invited to a Benefice Communion Service at Wilby at 10am.

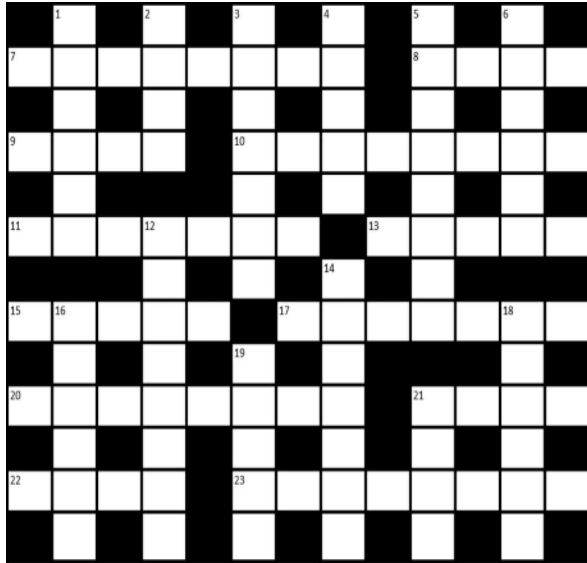
