Open Church and Churchyard Maintenance

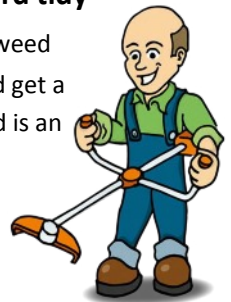
On the first Saturday of each month the church is open from 10am to 12noon for

Rector's Letter October 2018



In the Rectory office I have this picture of St Francis of Assisi stood by the window where it acts as a reminder of the wonderful world we live in and our need to care for it. On 4th October the Church remembers St. Francis and in some churches the Sunday nearest to that date is kept as Animal Welfare Sunday.

St. Francis lived in Italy in the 12th century. He grew up in a wealthy family, but as a young man, decided to give up his wealth and worldly possessions in order to live a very simple way of life.

Many stories and legends surround St Francis, many stemming from his ability to communicate with the animals and birds.

One story tells of a time when a wolf went into a town every evening, frightening the inhabitants and eating their animals. Francis went to speak to the wolf whom he called "Brother Wolf" and discovered that the wolf was behaving the way he was because he was hungry. Francis explained that being hungry was not reason enough frighten people and eat their animals. Francis blessed the wolf and the wolf became very gentle and in turn the people fed him and cared for him and the wolf played with the children, giving them rides on his back.

God has given us a wonderful world in which to live and has given us the task of caring for it. If we treat all of nature, the animals, birds, plants and people, gently and kindly, they will surely repay us many times over.

St Francis also found great delight and solace in the simple things of life, such as the rising of the sun; rainfall and the flowers of the hedgerow.

It is good to be reminded of this in our modern self-sufficient world and as the seasons change from summer to autumn maybe this month we can think about St Francis and with him give thanks for all the beauty which surrounds us.

COMMUNITY DEFIBRILLATOR ANNOUNCEMENT

Dear Residents

Ecton Parish Council is pleased to inform you we have joined a National effort to place an automated external defibrillator (AED) in the community, following concerns of ambulance response times for rural locations. To be used on victims of sudden cardiac arrest (heart attack).

A defibrillator is a portable machine that automatically sends an electric shock to the heart muscle to return it to its normal rhythm.

LOCATION: The defibrillator is placed on the outside wall of the outhouse situated at the Three Horse Shoes Public House, 23 High Street, Ecton.

AVAILABILITY: 24 hours a day.

IMPORTANT: In the event of an emergency please ring emergency services on 999 to obtain the cabinet access code.

ALARM - Please note upon opening the cabinet either a chime or a continuous alarm maybe activated. To stop the alarm remove the Defibrillator from the cabinet and close the door or remove the small purple magnet from inside the right hand side and place it upon the small rectangle box situated upon the right hand side of silver shelf.

YOU DO NOT NEED TO BE TRAINED TO USE THIS EQUIPMENT – THE DEVICE WILL TALK YOU THROUGH WHAT YOU NEED TO DO. REMEMBER TO DIAL 999 FIRST.

We will have a short training session sometime in October 2018, more information will follow shortly and will be place in the Ecton View and Ecton Noticeboards.

The defibrillator will be checked on a regular basis. If you have any concerns about the unit please contact the Parish Clerk on: ectonparishcouncil@yahoo.co.uk or 01604 700691

NOTE:

As we now have a defibrillator in the village. Bryan and Helen Bond have very kindly offered to do a basic introduction to first aid alongside an introduction to the use of the defibrillator on Sunday October 28th at 10.30a.m. for about two hours at the Village Hall. If you would like to take part please let me know on 403027 or 07850416429.
