Rectors Letter Ecton November 2018



I have recently watched the film Hacksaw Ridge, which tells the true story of Desmond Doss. Doss served as a Medic in World War II and single-handedly rescued 75 men from the top of the rock face known as Hacksaw Ridge, near Okinawa, Japan. Because of his beliefs he did this without a rifle and with God as his protector and strength. His faith and trust in Jesus, who made the ultimate sacrifice for us all 2000 years ago, gave Doss the strength and courage he needed to carry out the task he believed he had been called to do, to bring healing and peace into a war-torn world.

The film is not easy to watch, the horrors of war being portrayed in graphic detail, but we must never forget the sacrifices made by so many, in both World Wars and all the wars and conflicts since.

This year marks the Centenary of the end of the First World War and it will be those lives and all the countless others who have died since or have been injured whom we will be remembering on Remembrance Sunday.

On that day, 11th November, there will be a short service of Holy Communion at Ecton church at 10am followed by the service at the Shrine beginning at 10.45am.

There will be a Morning Prayer Service with hymns at Wilby church at 10am, moving to the war memorial in the churchyard at 10.50am.

There will be no morning service at Great Doddington but there will be a Remembrance Service at 6pm in church.

Remembrance Sunday reminds us of the starkness of death and just how many lives have been lost through war. May the ultimate sacrifice made for us by Jesus on the cross, give us, as it did Desmond Doss, strength and courage to work for good and to bring healing and peace to the world.

Lay Pastoral Ministry in the Church

On the 10th October at Gt Doddington Church, Ingrid Cartwright, Carol Hurst and I were relicensed to serve as Lay Pastoral Ministers in the Benefice. We were trained for this ministry by the Peterborough Diocese over a period of two years. The training is demanding. The first year was devoted to Bible study, in particular looking at the pastoral nature of God. The second year included Baptism and Confirmation preparation and visiting, at home, in hospitals and in care homes. We had guidance on bereavement visiting. At the end of this part of my training I remember a visit to a funeral director and hearing the undertaker's stories.

During the training I learned about working in small groups, such as PCC meetings, Ministry Team meetings and house groups. At a deeper level there was a section on Transactional Analysis where I learned much about myself.

The role of a Lay Pastoral Minister is about listening. As we listen, we listen to God. He speaks to us through the scriptures and our prayer life, but he also speaks to us through the people we serve.

As well as our pastoral responsibilities we are licensed by the Bishop to serve at Holy Communion in church and to take the sacrament to the sick, at home and in hospital. All this we do under Rev Jackie's authority, direction and supervision.

Listening is the key to our work. These words by Henri Nouwen, a Roman Catholic priest who worked with men and women with profound learning disabilities are important to me. "Listening is the highest form of hospitality.....Hospitality is not to change people, but to offer them space where change can take place."
