Rector's Letter February 2019



On 14th February we celebrate St Valentine's Day, a day connected with love and the joining together of couples. It is a day that is very special to Derick and me as it was the day, in 1986, when we got engaged and yes, he did go down on one knee.

Little is known about St Valentine. Born in the third century he was a priest and possible a Bishop of Terni in Italy. He was martyred for his faith around the year 269 at Rome by the Emperor Claudius.

The connection of Valentine's Day with love can be traced back to a Pagan Festival of the 14th Century and in Medieval times it was the day when traditionally, according to proverbial wisdom, the birds would choose their mates "*On St Valentine's Day, all the birds of the air, in couples do join*". For Christians, St Valentine's Day can also be a reminder that we have a loving God who created the world and loves us unconditionally, and the First Sunday Praise and Worship Service this month will focus on God's love. Held at St. Nicholas Church, Great Doddington on **Sunday 3rd February at 4pm** the service takes place in the coffee area of the church.

The service is for about an hour and includes prayers; a Bible reading and short reflection, with the opportunity for people to share their own thoughts and something of their own Christian journey. Modern worship songs are sung, using a power point presentation. At the moment we are using recorded music, but if there is anyone who plays a guitar or keyboard and would like to join us and lead some of the songs, you would be most welcome. If you have never been to the service before, why not give it a try?

Amid all the uncertainty and changes we are experiencing in our country at this time, it is good to be reminded that we have a God who loves us, a love that can be seen all around us, not least as the birds find their mates and the cold earth once again brings forth abundant new life.

R.O.C.K. Club Fundraising

Over the Christmas period I ran a variety of activities to raise funds for the R.O.C.K. club, the social club for adults with acquired brain injuries in the Northamptonshire area that I help to run. Many of you know of Headway, an organisation that concentrates on occupational rehab and support for adults with brain injuries, well we focus on social and leisure events for the same group of service users.

Much of that fundraising has been supported by residents and friends of Ecton village. The activities included selling wreaths and Christmas floristry and running workshops for the same, and the Ecton village Christmas quiz (which on its own raised £850 for the R.O.C.K. club and village church combined). Altogether, it amounted to £2,367.84, way more than I anticipated and all thanks to local support. As well as covering all the catering costs through the year, we have been able to purchase a new sound system for discos, quizzes, bingo and the like. There is also sufficient to help towards the costs of other entertainment for the club.

I would like to offer my profound thanks to all those that supported me, and everyone that wished me well in my efforts. We had our Christmas dinner for the beneficiaries of the club at the Marriott hotel on the 17th December and I was able to pass on the good news at that event.



I hope that everyone that supported the village events that went towards the R.O.C.K. club enjoyed themselves, I plan to run similar events for Christmas 2019.

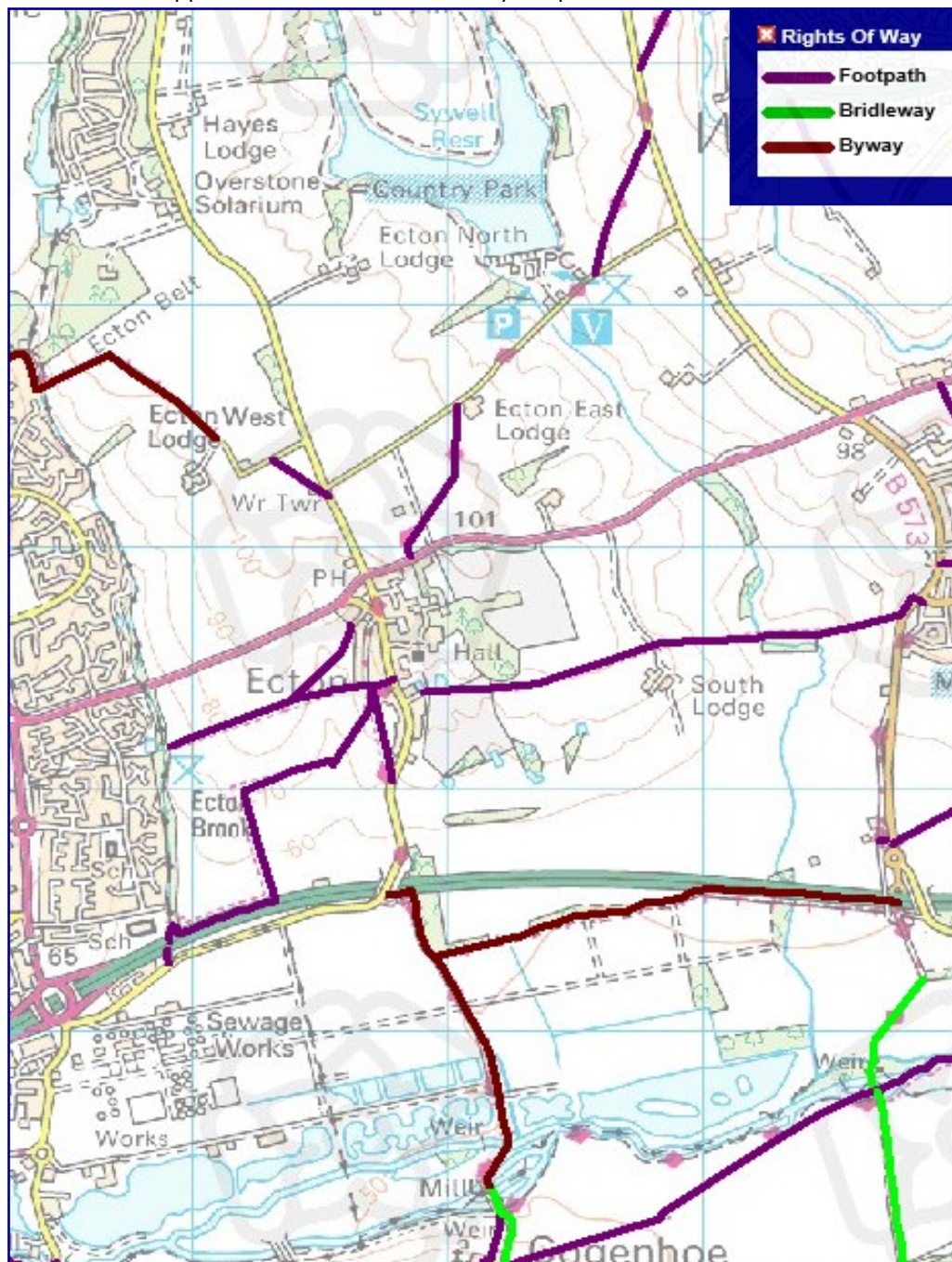

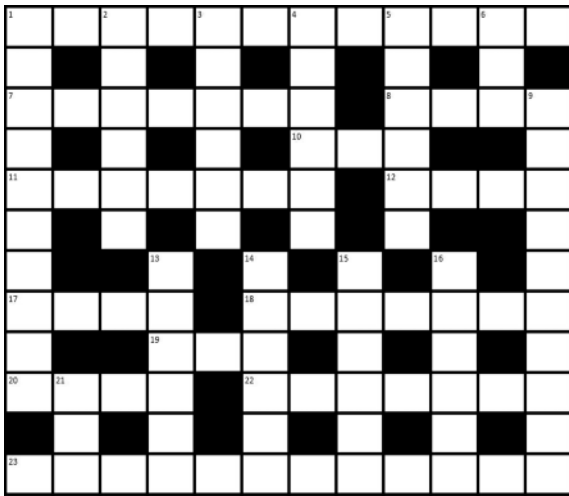

1 Anagram, alluded to by "somehow". It's 12 long, the number of letters in "PAL CAN BE CUTE" which leaves "unwelcome" as the definition

8 Hidden word, alluded to by "to hold", "yeAHABLE" Captain Ahab hunted Moby Dick.

17 "Initially" implies the first letters of a phrase, so "N", "E", "R" and "O".

18 The French for red is rouge. H is the recognised abbreviation for hot and R for right. Leaving "less gently" as the definition. So "H" inside "ROUGE" with "R" following.

22 Anagram, alluded to by "confused". It's 7 long, the number of letters in "DEAD AND" leaving "at the end" as the definition.

23 & 10 This is the Ecton clue. Anagram, alluded to by "make up". It's 15 long, the number of letters in "NEWS WIMMIN MIGHT". The cinema night is on Feb 8th.

1 Anagram, alluded to by "at sea". It's 10 long, the number of letters in "GUY IN NICHE" leaving "insanitary" as the definition.

5 This is a word puzzle. Remove the first letter ("loses initial") from a fruit to get a French word for another fruit. "(B)ANANAS"
