Ecton Parish Council - A guide into the use of Highways and Parish Council Salt bins

The salt bins in Ecton are provided by Northampton County Council and four have recently been adopted by the Parish Council because NCC were going to remove them.

The salt provided in the grit bins is to be used only on public roads and footpaths in the Parish. Parishioners are encouraged to use the salt to help keep the roads and foot paths safe during extreme weather conditions.

Unfortunately salt bins can be misused as residents mistakenly think the salt is provided to grit their own pathways. Please be aware that Residents should purchase their own salt for use on their driveways as this stipulation is not abundantly clear.

Can I use the salt to grit a private property?

No. The salt in the highways salt bins is for use by the public on public roads, pedestrian areas and footways only. The salt must not be used to grit private properties. Highways regularly monitor the salt levels in the bins according to weather conditions. If they discover salt levels decreasing beyond what the demand should be, there may be inappropriate usage of the salt, which may force Highways to remove the salt bin permanently.

Why does the council provide salt bins? Can't it do all the gritting instead?

It's not possible for Highways gritters to spread salt on every road and pavement in the borough. They therefore provide salt bins at key locations throughout the borough to allow residents, motorists and pedestrians to spread the salt on the public highway and pedestrian areas.

Open Church and Churchyard Maintenance

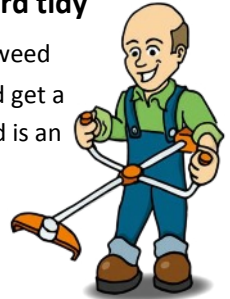
On the first Saturday of each month the church is open from 10am to 12noon for

Spring not only heralds in the lighter nights and warmer days but is also the season when we celebrate Easter, this year on 21st April. A celebration, the greatest in the Christian calendar which is preceded by a time of waiting, the season of Lent.

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, which this year is on 6th March. There will be a service at 7.30pm at Great Doddington church and we will be reminded of our own mortality and our need of repentance, saying sorry for the things we have done wrong and asking for God's forgiveness.

We will receive the sign of the cross, in ash prepared from last year's palm crosses, on our fore heads with the words "Remember you are dust and to dust you shall return. Turn away from sin and be faithful to Christ"

And so begins the season of Lent, a period of 40 days (46 if you include Sundays) which also reminds us of the time Jesus spent in the wilderness before his ministry began. Some people find it helpful to give something up for Lent, for example chocolate, as the season is one of fasting. Others take something up, committing maybe to spending more time in prayer or reading the Bible or other literature.

This year I am committing to two disciplines, firstly giving up chocolate, which will be a challenge! I have done it before, a few years ago, and it certainly acts as a reminder and a conversation starter about Lent.

The other discipline is reading the Lent book and attending the Course. The book we are using this year is *Lent with New Daylight* £2.50. You can just read the book, which has a reading and prayer for each day, or you can also come along to the course. Starting on Thursday 7th March we will meet between 11.30am – 1.30pm at Great Doddington Church. We will discuss the weeks readings, have lunch, (please bring your own, drinks provided) and then spend some time quietly reflecting using various prayer stations.

If we use the season of Lent well then, the waiting time can make our celebrations of Easter more meaningful and we will be more ready to meet the risen Lord on Easter Day. Please do contact me if you would like further information or guidance and may you have a very blessed Lent.

fighting for young people's mental health

I moved in to Ecton two years ago with my husband and three teenage children. We have settled in really well and love living here. I am often out walking my two dogs around the fields surrounding the village and there is always a friendly face who will stop and say hello. This year I am going to be running the London Marathon for the first time in aid of YoungMinds. A challenge which is both exciting and terrifying in equal measures. The charity is very important to me and that is what is helping me through the cold wet training runs I have been doing recently. I am determined I will get round the 26.2 miles and raise as much money as I can for YoungMinds.

YoungMinds are the UK's leading charity committed to improving the wellbeing and mental health of children and young people. The charity works closely with young people and families, and campaigns on a number of issues impacting young people and their mental health. YoungMinds run a parents helpline which can be reached on 08088025544. The helpline offers free advice and support to any adult who's worried about the behaviour or mental health of a young person. There is also an enormous amount of information and support available on the YoungMinds website and via their social media.

I first became aware of the charity when I turned to them for support when one of my own children was unwell. I found the information invaluable at a time when I was finding it very difficult to get my child the help they needed and I have since started working for them as a parent advisor. I also volunteer on one of their telephone support lines that offers parents the chance to talk to somebody in confidence. 

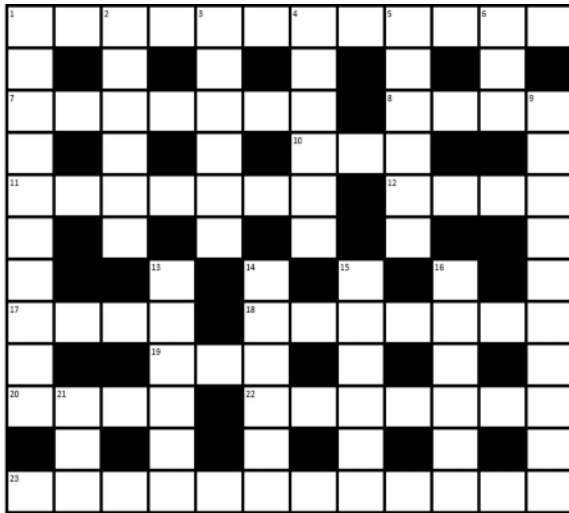
