On the first Saturday of each month the church is open from 10am to 12noon for

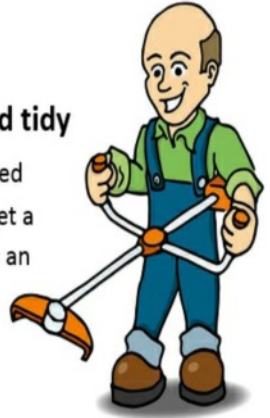

Rector's Letter August 2019

“The Lord God took the man and put him in the Garden of Eden to work it and take care of it” Genesis 2:15



This year we went to Exmouth, South Devon, for our holiday. While we were there we visited some gardens, namely Bicton Gardens and Buckland Abbey. Both were beautiful, in their own way. Bicton was very formal, with beds laid out in order and hardly a weed in sight. Gardeners were busy hoeing and deadheading and the planting and colour schemes were amazing. In contrast, Buckland Abbey, not to be confused with Buckfast Abbey, was more informal, comprising an assortment of small gardens, often hidden away and surrounded by stone walls. Shrubs had been given the freedom to grow where and how they wanted, the layout was that of a cottage garden and the vegetable garden was something to behold. We saw only two gardeners while there, both working on the vegetable patch and both very relaxed in their work.

Both gardens were beautiful and very peaceful, in different ways, and while I felt more at home at Buckland, Bicton certainly gave us pause for thought.

As many of you know, both Derick and I enjoy gardening and take great pleasure in working in the Rectory garden, Derick even more so, since his retirement. But gardening shouldn't be all about work, so very often, Derick and I will stop for a while and enjoy all God has created, taking time out to simply be, to watch the birds and insects and to soak up some of nature's beauty, because as the saying goes *"One is closer to God in the garden, than anywhere else on earth"*.

That said, we have been working hard in recent weeks to get the garden looking as good as we can ready for the Open Rectory event which takes place on **Saturday 10th August 2pm – 4.30pm**. As well as enjoying the garden, which will certainly not be up to show standard, but hopefully interesting and relaxing, there will be refreshments, various stalls, including a produce and plant stall, and good company.

Do come along if you can, you will be made most welcome. Entry is free and money raised will be split between the churches of Great Doddington, Wilby and Ecton.

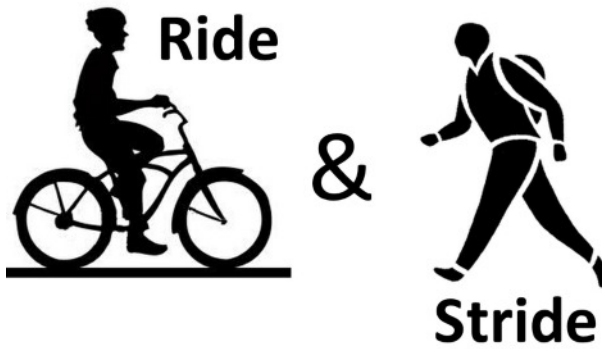

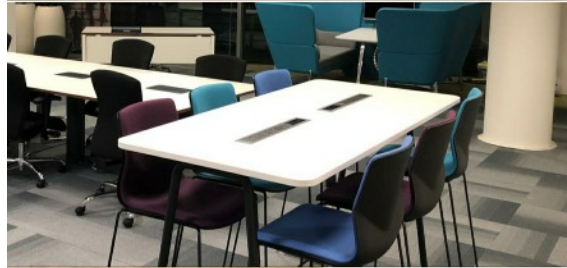

This warning comes from the Police and British Telecom and relates to actions similar to phishing where rather than trying to obtain your personal details by email the method used is phone scamming. Ultimately they are trying to persuade you to transfer money or give away confidential information.

Vishing is a risk to us all at home and at work. We need to be on our guard every time we answer a call. Please consider the following points:

If you are being asked to provide sensitive information or to complete an action - STOP and THINK

Do you know this person and can you validate and check who they are?

Were you expecting the call?

Never share your payment or bank account details over the phone.

Check them out on an official company web site, and only call numbers from websites you know are genuine.

Call a friend and speak to them before calling back or use a different phone line to ensure the fraudsters aren't intercepting your outgoing calls.

Don't be rushed, if they are genuine they won't mind you checking them out.

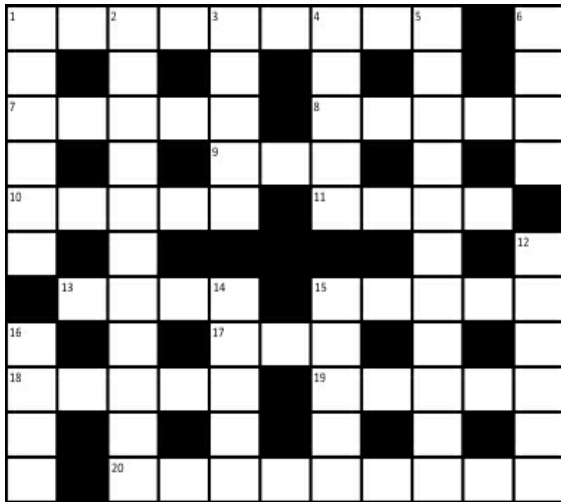
