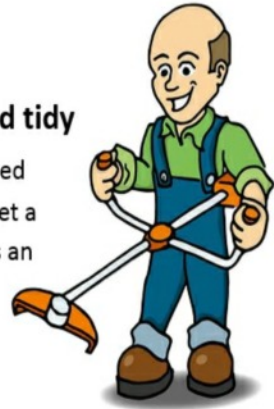
## Churchyard Maintenance and Open Church

## Rector's Letter September 2019 Ecton



I am occasionally asked if I believe in angels and the answer is “Yes, I do!”.

Angels feature regularly in the Bible, in both the Old and New Testaments, usually in the role of Messengers from God. There are three named angels in the Bible Michael, Gabriel and Raphael.

Gabriel is probably the best known, featuring in the Nativity story as God’s Messenger to Mary and Joseph. Michael, which means 'who is like God?', is described as the protector of Israel and leader of the armies of God and is perhaps best known as the slayer of the dragon in the Revelation to John. Raphael, whose name means “God has healed” is mentioned in the Book of Tobit, (a book found in a section, not included in all Bibles, called the Apocrypha). After Raphael had healed Tobit he identified himself as one of the seven heavenly angels.

On 29<sup>th</sup> September the Church celebrates the feast day of Michael and All Angels, a day chosen after a basilica near Rome was dedicated, in the fifth century, in honour of Michael on 30<sup>th</sup> September. The celebrations began on the eve of that day, and 29<sup>th</sup> September is now kept in honour of Michael and All Angels throughout the western Church.

This year the feast day falls on a Sunday and as it is a fifth Sunday the three churches in our benefice will worship together at 10am at Ecton. This is most appropriate as Ecton has two stunning stained-glass windows depicting some of the angels found in the Bible. Do join us if you can and after the service have a look at the windows, in the south and east walls of the side chapel. There is also a wooden plaque behind the door giving a description of each panel.

Before that do come along to Great Doddington’s Scarecrow Festival, being organised by Village, on Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> September. As well as numerous scarecrows around the village, the Church will have several tableaux depicting angel scenes from the Bible. All welcome, please contact Jackie for more details.

I look forward to seeing you at these and other events around the benefice this month and do look out for a scarecrow, dressed as a vicar, somewhere in Great Doddington, that may well look a bit like me as well!

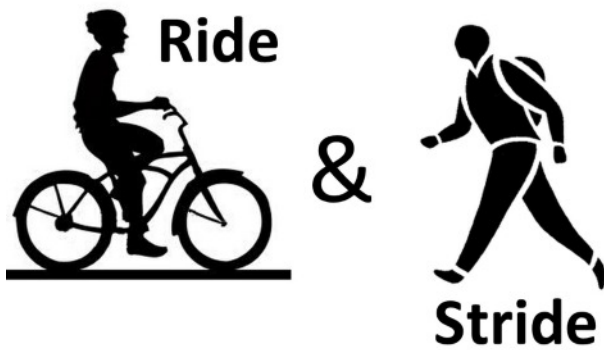

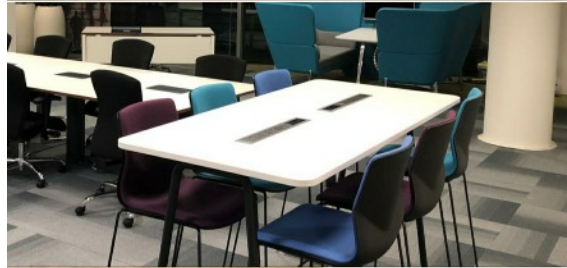

## Dementia Sings Out

Together with several existing members of the Wellingborough Community Gospel Choir from Ecton I am helping to support our choirs latest community initiative in Wellingborough. A weekly choir which meets on a Thursday morning to sing and socialise together with dementia sufferers and their companions.

The very real pleasure that we see in people each week makes us feel so very blessed with our own health and ability to be independent so that I certainly do not feel ashamed to ask for your practical help and support yet again. It's too early to talk about Sherry and Mince pies yet, but later in the year I will arrange a fund raising day here in my home.

At the present time and hopefully stretching over the next few years commercial sponsorship has been obtained to pay our choir director Gareth Fuller.

The Everyday Champions Church in Havelock Street allows us to use their premises and other generous private individuals supply the refreshments. However, several of the groups of people who come along have to travel by disabled taxi together with their companion and we are told that at the moment none of the local taxi companies are willing to offer any kind of discount. For instance one group from a care home in Barton Seagrave is charged £28 each way to and from Wellingborough and that is very rapidly using up all of their social funding within the care home. During the next few weeks I intend to approach all of our local taxi companies and appeal to their sense of commitment to the local community in their town but in this very uncertain political and financial climate I can understand their reluctance to make a contribution.

If you feel that you can help in any way we as a choir would be most grateful. Come along one Thursday morning and feel the JOY. If you can contribute any financial help at all please drop it in to me at The Old Chapel, West Street. I will ensure that you receive a receipt along with our grateful thanks. There but for the Grace of God is how I feel each time I sing 'Saturday Night at the Movies' or 'Stand By Me' and see people singing along or just tapping their feet to the music.
