Church Notices - January

Work on the Church Roof

The work on the church roof began, as expected, on 23 September 2019 and was expected to be completed by 25 October 2019 but, as you will all be aware, the external scaffolding is still in place. When the lead was removed from the roof it became clear that there was dry rot in some of the roof timbers. This wasn't entirely unexpected and the new finish date was early November. As work progressed, it became clear that the dry rot was much more extensive and the contractors found 'fruiting bodies', a particularly unpleasant fungus, in the wall plate that supports the chancel roof. We were given the choice as to whether we replaced the wall plate or not. However, if we chose not to replace it, the chancel roof would have eventually collapsed. The additional work has meant that scaffolding has now been erected inside the church so that the roof can be raised slightly to allow the decaying wood to be replaced. The completion date is now the middle of December, assuming that no additional problems are found.

The overall additional costs are approximately £13,500. We are so grateful for the additional monies that have been received from recent fund raising events in the village and donations from individuals. We are so fortunate that so many people support the church. Thank you!

Valuable Piles of Leaves

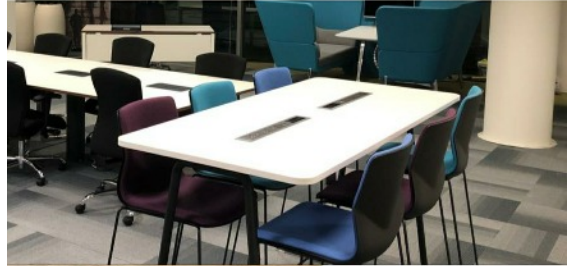

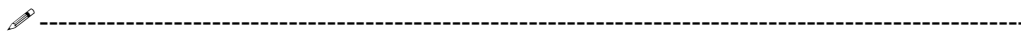
OLD ECTON IN PHOTOGRAPHS

Pictorial Map of Ecton in 1830s



The Pictorial map of Ecton in 1830s was produced by Rodney Ingram in 2009 in a limited edition of 30 printed on canvas.

I have had several requests for a reprint of the map but decline to do so for two reasons. Firstly, the cost of canvas and printing has escalated making it uneconomic for most people who would like to own one.

Secondly, the owners of the original print are happy that they have a very limited edition print. However, I have decided once again to have another small further print run made of the map, size A1, on very good quality paper that would be suitable for framing at a more reasonable cost. The Pictorial Map depicts the village of Ecton in the early 1830s. It is based on a map produced for Ambrose Isted, who had inherited Ecton estate in 1827 and, like the original map, it shows the cottages owned by the estate and the names of the tenants. The numbering of the cottages accords with the original map. The villagers' occupations were not shown on the original map but have been deduced (where possible) from census and other records. In addition to the tenants of the cottages, the original estate map also names other householders, some of whom were also tenants but a very few who were Rectorial tenants; they are included also.

The maps are available to purchase together with an accompanying booklet of interesting information about Ecton and its 1830 inhabitants at a total cost of £40.
