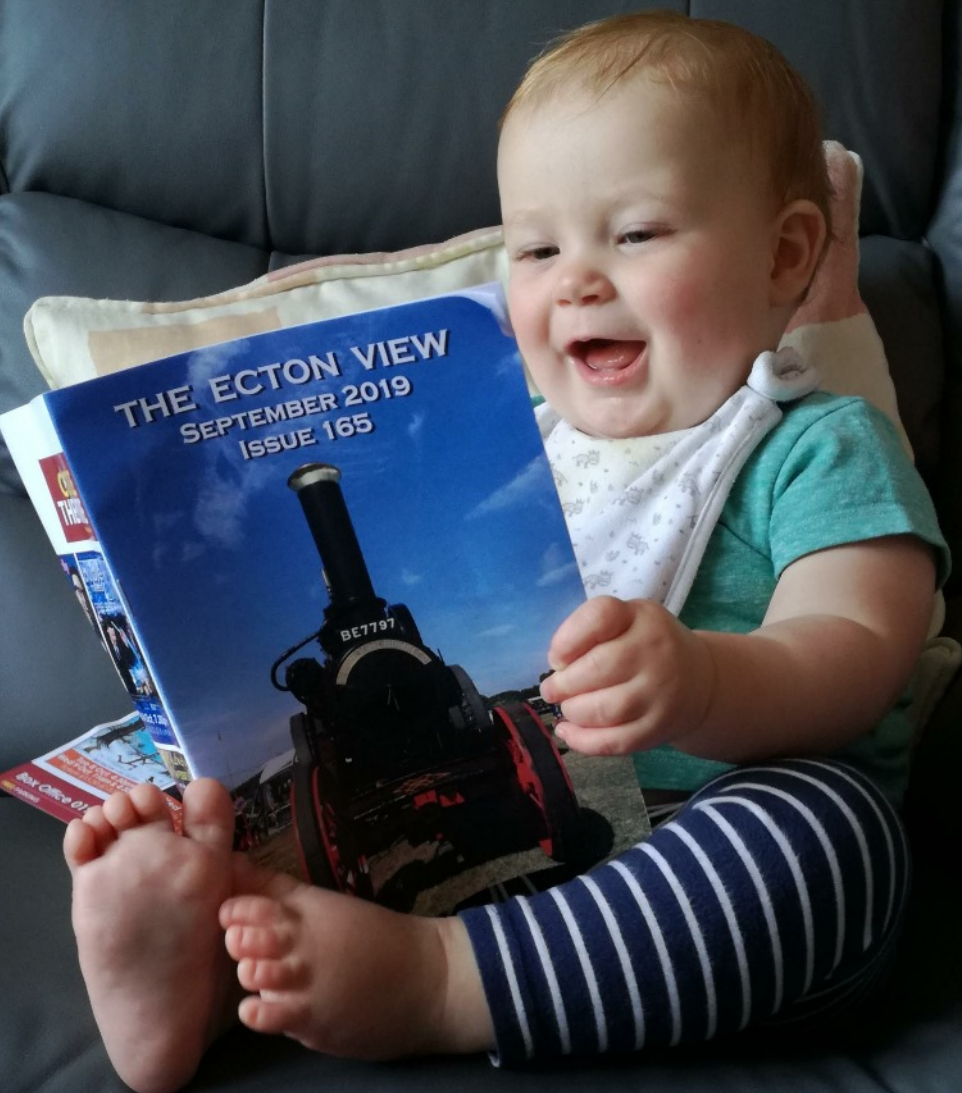

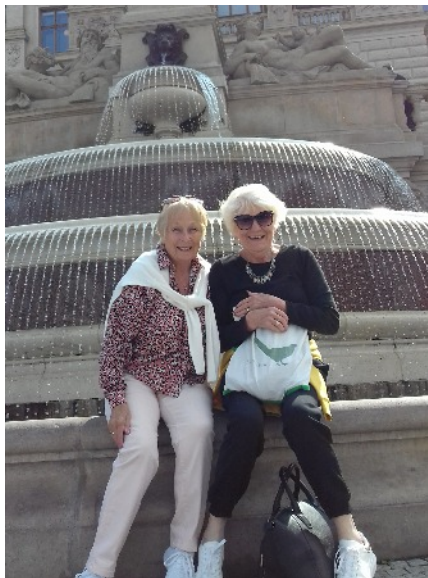

Some trees and hedges are overhanging footpaths and obstructing vision for drivers as well as making it difficult for walkers. We are in discussion with Greatwell Homes and the County Council about the verge from Franklin's Close up to the A4500 and hope that they will respond before you read this.

On the first Saturday of each month the church is open from 10am to 12noon for

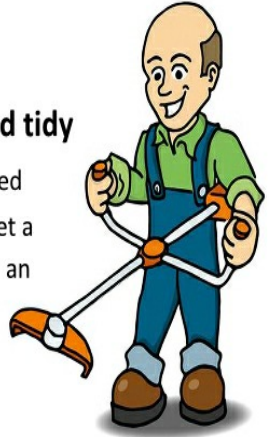
tea and coffee.

## Rector's Letter October 2019



Next year I will have been ordained Priest for 10 years and I have lost count of the number of baptisms, weddings and funerals I have presided over. Each occasion different, yet in many ways the same. For the church has a set liturgy, or wording, for specific services and often similar passages from the Bible are read, giving a familiarity and comfort to those present. For baptism the words, from the Gospel of Mark chapter 10 verses 13-16, capture perfectly the welcome the church gives, both to children and adults, as they join the church through the sacrament of baptism “Jesus welcomed the little children, took them up in his arms, laid his hands on them, and blessed them”. For a wedding, the words from 1 Corinthians chapter 13 verses 1-13 are often read, it being a beautiful passage which talks about love as being patient and kind and able to endure all things. But I think it is at a funeral that scripture can really help us and comforts us, giving us an understanding that death is not the end but a new beginning, a beginning bought for us by the sacrifice made by Jesus on the cross. Words such as “Do not be afraid... for I go to prepare a place for you...” from the Gospel of John chapter 14 verses 1-6 Major life events can signal a new chapter in a person's life. Baptism, the beginning of a journey of faith; a wedding, of a new relationship, blessed by God; a bereavement, while bringing sadness to those who mourn, begins, Christians believe, a new life in heaven for the person who has died, a life lived in the full presence of God forever. Life, especially after the death of a loved one, will never be the same again but we can keep the memory of those who have died alive in our hearts forever, and with this in mind, there will be a Benefice Memorial Service on **Sunday 20th October at 3pm at Wilby Church**. A service to remember and give thanks for the lives of those who have died. It is a service for everyone, whether your loss is recent or many years ago, whether you usually come to church or not. We will meet in the main part of the church for about 45 minutes, after which refreshments will be served. The service will be quiet and reflective with hymns, readings, a short address, prayers and the opportunity to light a candle in memory of our loved ones.

Everyone is welcome.

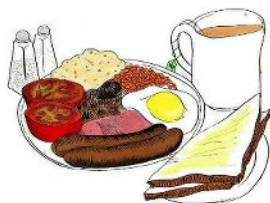
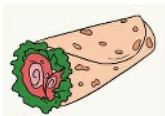

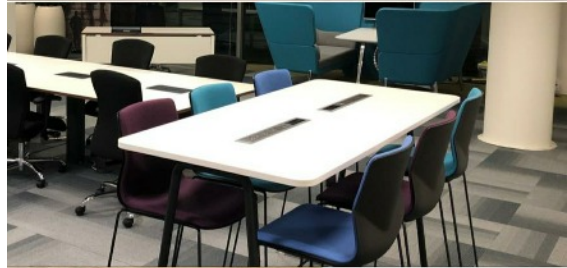

## **Ecton Community Speed Watch**

You might be interested in knowing a little more about the Community Speed Watch taking place in the village through till the middle of October. Parishes can be asked to be nominated to be equipped and trained by the local police to assist with speed awareness in their community if there is a perception of a problem with either safety or driver behaviour locally. The bottom line is we would like Ecton to feel safe and our village environment to remain pleasant. Part of that is making people aware or reminding them that travelling down the High St. at a reasonable speed is a reasonable ask. There is no attempt at covert record taking, signs are up, the team wear hi-viz and stand at the end of a long sight line. This is essentially another way of saying thanks for driving considerately if you are, please think about our village residents if you aren't. Being part of the speed watch team is quite an interesting observational exercise in human behaviour. 90% of drivers just drive on by without much to note, except perhaps a thumbs up or supportive greeting. A few drivers have an alarmed expression on their faces, either because they aren't sure what speed they were doing, they can't remember what the limit is or they are over the limit. Very occasionally we get a sarcastic comment, a one fingered salute or verbal equivalent, and very occasionally people accelerate aggressively after they have passed us to achieve some personal message of their own rationale. A couple of cyclists have shouted a request to measure their speed as they head towards and we try to oblige.

You might also be interested to know that the speed camera van that occasionally parks at the top of the village to monitor traffic along the A4500 has a relatively high hit rate for reporting speeding drivers. But anyone trying to cross the road to or from the bus stop opposite the World's End is likely to be grateful for a strategy that helps keep driver speed down to something sensible, as would anyone driving out of the village that way.

I hope that helps put the objectives in perspective. The survey is done by volunteers, so thank you to all those that have offered supportive comments as we stand there with camera and clipboard.

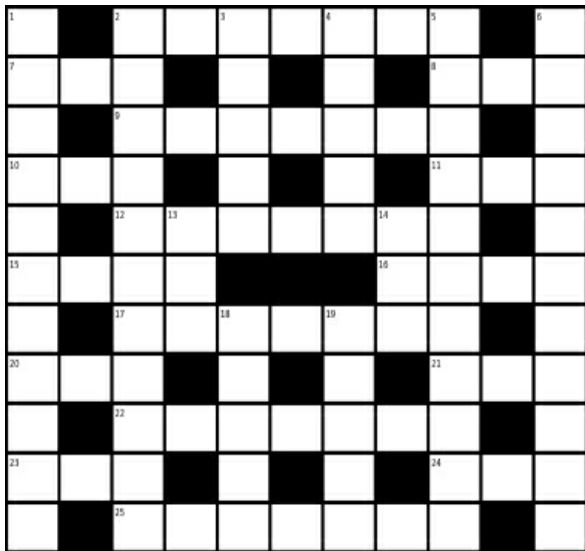

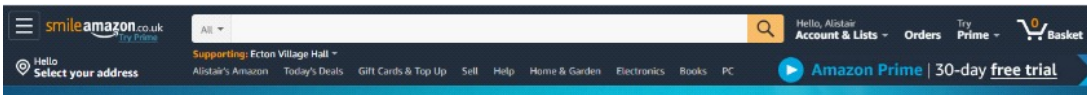
