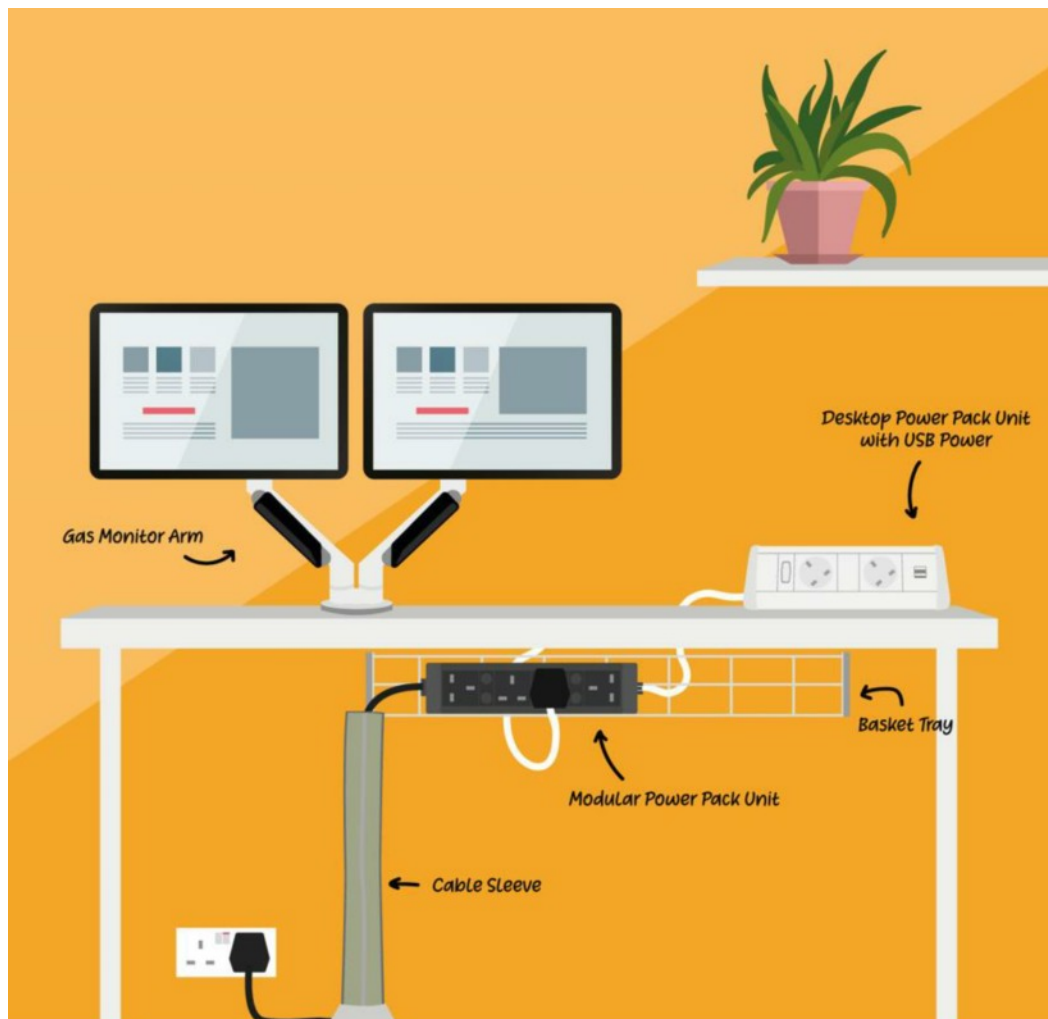

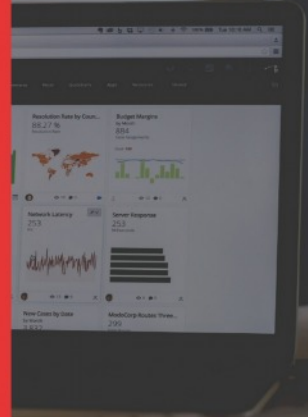

Spring Blossom

I expect you have seen the blackthorn and cherry blossom on trees in gardens and by the roadside. Hawthorn and fruit tree blossom come a bit later – April/May. There is nothing like blossom on trees to lift the spirits. Why not take a trip out to see an orchard in blossom. Lyveden New Bield and Anglesey Abbey are good places to visit. Lots of places have Easter events too. Even if you go for a local walk there will be lots of signs of spring to see and hear. I wish everyone a happy Easter.

Habitat for Ground Nesting Bees

How about giving these bees a helping hand.

Container – large plant pot, box or wooden frame.

Fill – 2 portions of sand, 1 portion of gravel and ½ portion of top soil.

Mix well and spray with warm water using an old CLEAN spray bottle. Press down well and repeat this for a few days.

Holes – use a pencil to make holes 8-13mm diameter as deep as will go and 2cm between holes.

Site – Place at ground level south facing if possible and slightly tilted so rainwater runs off. Positioning near flowers (especially daisies) is ideal too.

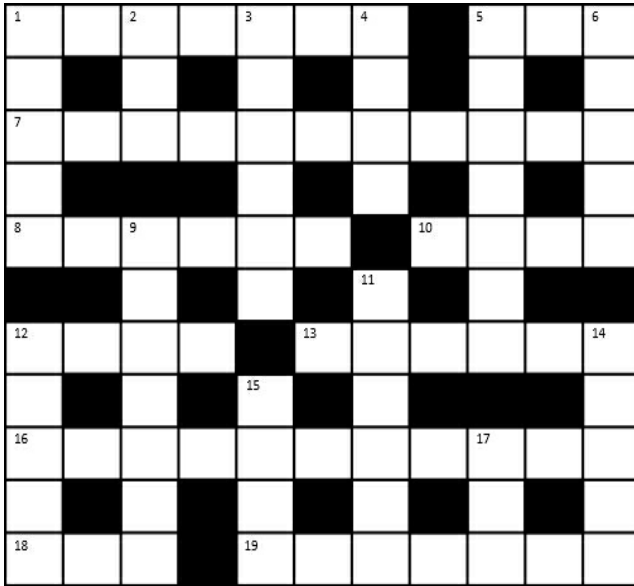
