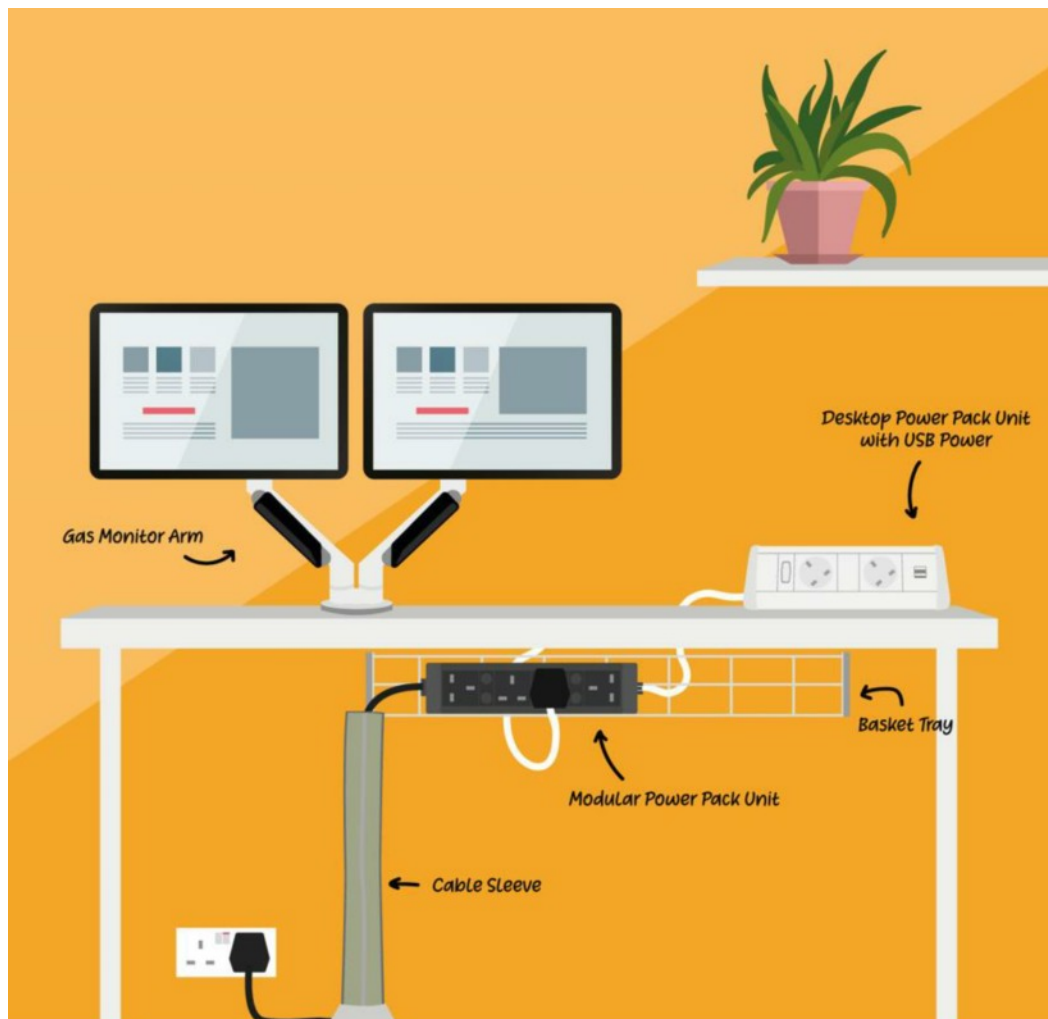

Rector's Letter
October 2022



As life returns to some sort of normal again, after the death of Queen Elizabeth II, people are beginning to look for ways to honour the Queen's memory. No doubt many monuments will be erected and places and events named after her, and rightly so, but surely the best way to honour her memory is by following her good example of faithful service.

On her 21st birthday the young Elizabeth made this promise “ *I declare before you all that my whole life whether it be long or short shall be devoted to your service... God help me make good my vow and God bless all of you who are willing to share in it*” It was a promise she would express again at her Coronation and kept all her life.

King Charles III has already pledged to serve with “*loyalty, respect and love*” and, like his mother before him, will look to us to support him, through our words, actions and prayers.

In many ways we are, as individuals, a country and a world, in a time of great change. Changes in leadership, economic changes and climate change, but one thing remains constant and that is God.

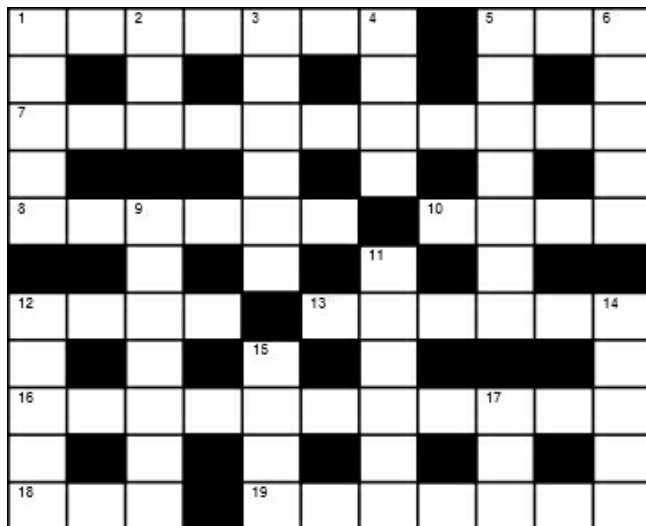
