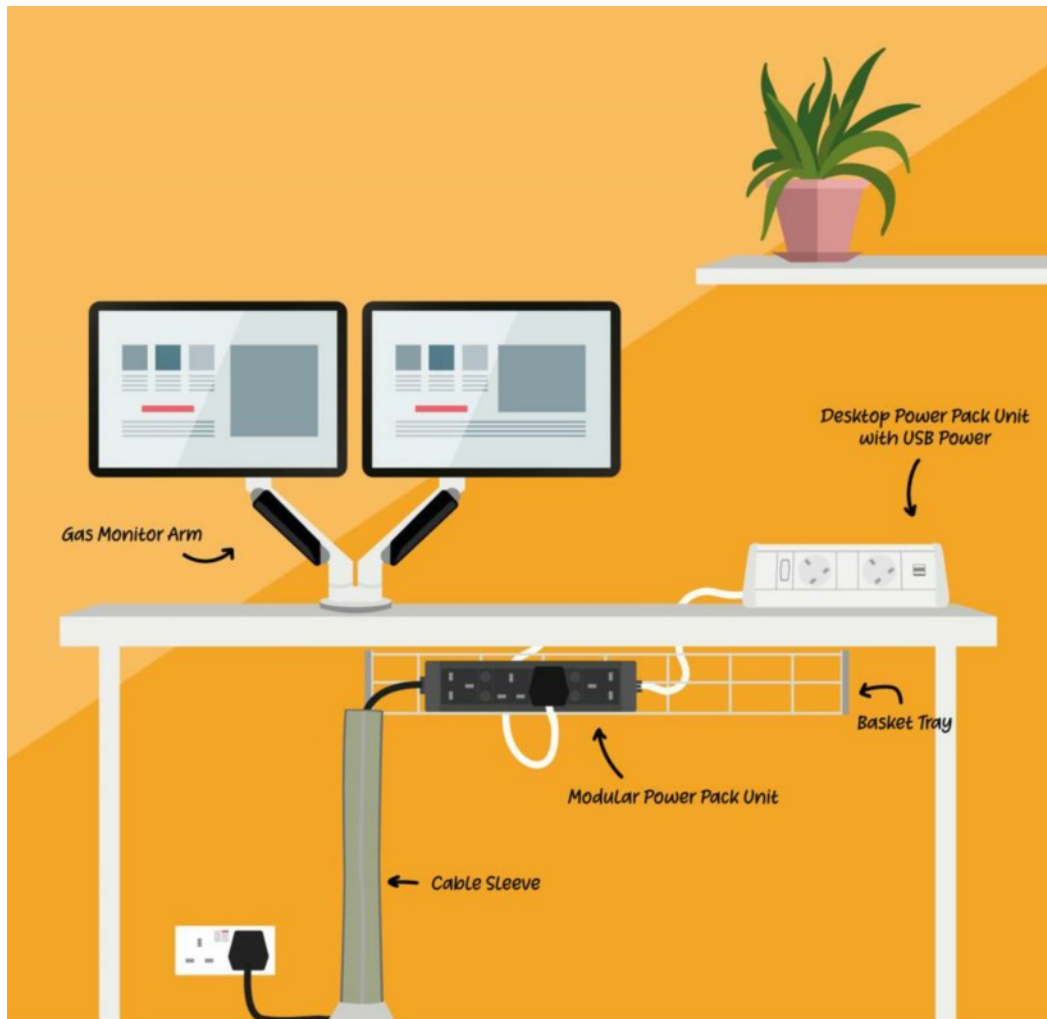

December 2023



*"The shepherds were astonished to find the night sky filled with angels singing God's praise. And before long they were singing, too ... Centuries later, singing is still central to how many of us celebrate Christmas. "We invite you this Christmas to follow the star, journey to the manger, join the song and come into the presence of Jesus Christ."*

The theme of this year's Church of England Christmas campaign is *Follow the Star: Join the Song*, inspired by the story of how the shepherds returned to the fields praising God, after seeing the baby Jesus.

Singing can draw us closer to God and to each other as we celebrate the birth of Christ and has always been a part of Christian worship, including the Psalms, sung worship, hymns and modern worship songs. As you would expect our services over Christmas include many well known carols and we hope you will be able to join us.

The Christmas cards, detailing the church services and events in December, are included with Ecton View this month. Our thanks go to those who have distributed these for us.

A couple of highlights for Ecton include the traditional Carol Service on Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> December 6pm and a new service on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> December 2pm called Blue Christmas, a quiet, reflective service for anyone who finds Christmas difficult or who simply want a quieter service.

This year Midnight Mass will be at Great Doddington 11.15pm and the Christmas morning service is at Wilby at 10am. Ecton church will be open Christmas morning between 9.30am -10.30am for quiet prayer.

May I wish you a very blessed and peaceful Christmas, as we sing together to celebrate once more the birth of Jesus.

## Dementia Sings Out

Many of you here in Ecton know that I sing with the Wellingborough Community Gospel Choir and lots of you have been kind enough to support me for the last twelve years as we sing in the village churches all over Northamptonshire.

What you may not know is that each Thursday morning between 10.30am and 12pm we have an offshoot choir which meets to support the needs of almost hundred people in Wellingborough who suffer from dementia in its various forms. We meet at the Compass church on Finedon Road and it has become over the last five years more of a club than a choir. Many local Care homes come along with some of their carers and their clients, who enjoy such a great party each week singing and dancing along to favourite songs that featured in the hit parades in the 1960s and 1970s. Some of our favourites are Roger Millers 'King of the Road'. Elvis, 'Return to Sender' and The Drifters 'Come on over to my place'. We always finish with either 'Love Train' and 'My Boy Lollipop'. Everyone joins in and has a real party, then we finish with tea or coffee with biscuits.

All this needs to be freely available to everyone whether they have dementia or not and we have a regular group of people who join us just for the company. We would love to invite you to pop over to Wellingborough one Thursday morning just to experience the joy that we all feel each time we meet.

But, of course as as often the case with me, there is a special request. Each year just before our Christmas break we enjoy an informal Christmas Party. This year on **14th December**. Although we get Lottery funding as well as other generous business sponsorship for the everyday running of the choir, there really is no money in the kitty for entertaining. Now that each week up to 100 people join us, even providing light refreshments is expensive.

For the Christmas party I am happy to take on the catering at cost which includes sausage rolls and mince pies and individual quiches but it would be appropriate to put them on festive plates with napkins and crackers. It would be lovely if I could find either several individuals or a business that would help me by sharing the cost of the food and disposable table ware. Do please call me if you are happy to contribute in any way to make lots of lovely people even happier than they are already each Thursday morning. And of course, you are invited to the Christmas Party!

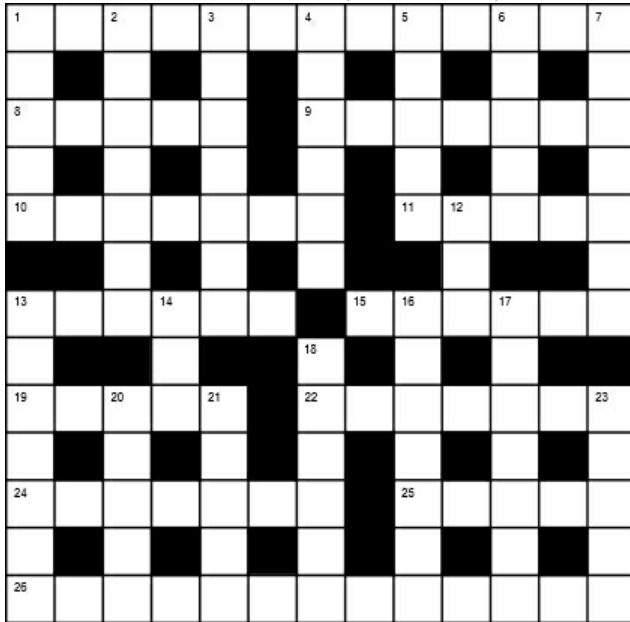
