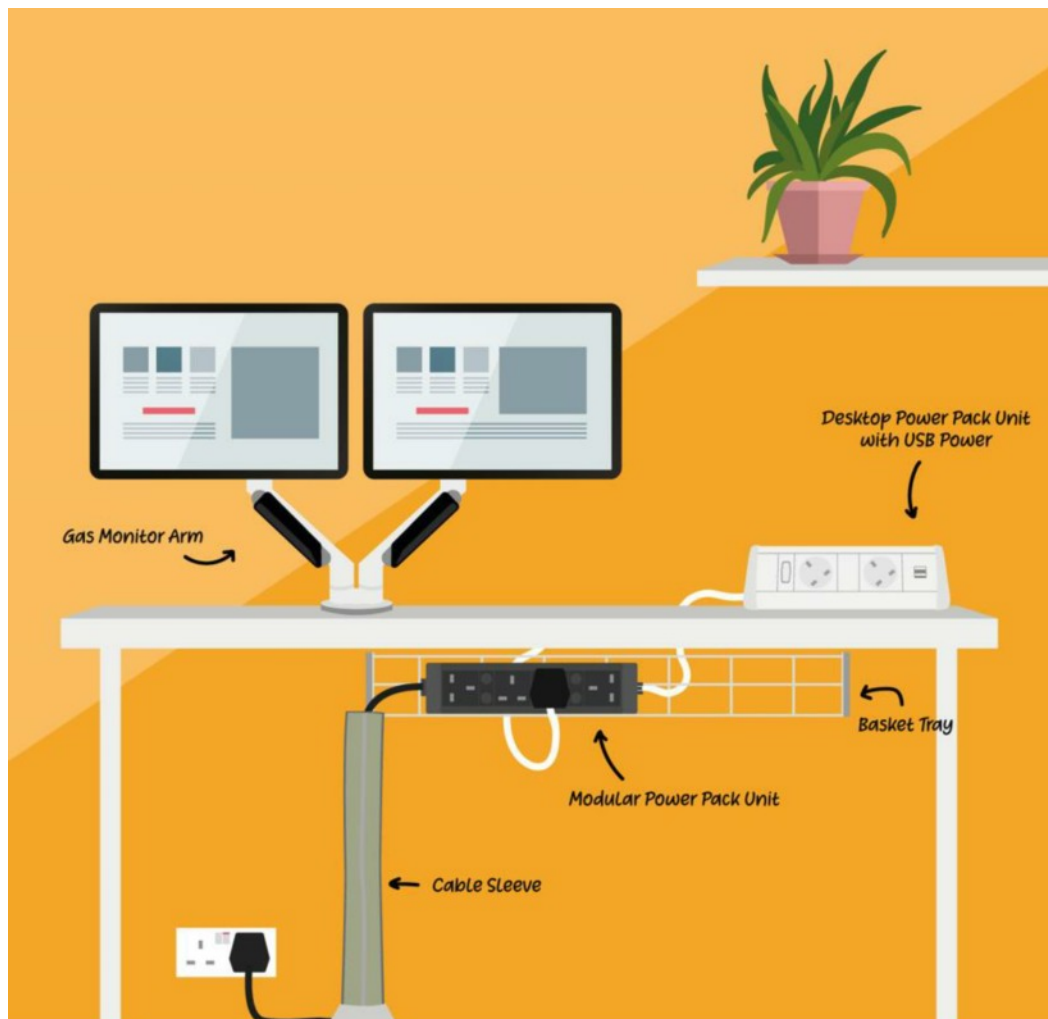

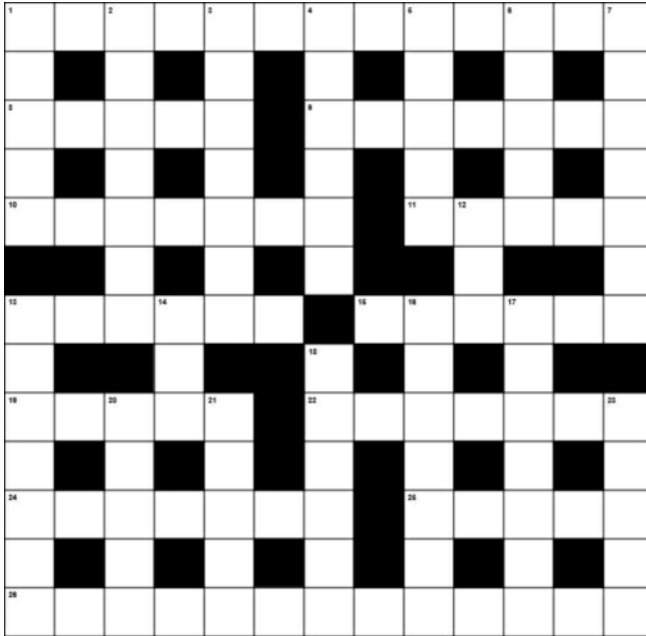

The NHS and “Wild June”

The NHS as part of their “Greener NHS Programme” is supporting “The Wildlife Trust 30 Days Wild in June” this year. Most people now know the health benefits of nature for our mental and physical well being, so do something “wild” in June – if not each day then perhaps once or twice a week.

Birds and Cats

Parent birds are busy breeding and feeding young now and both adults and young are susceptible to attacks by cats. Do think about putting a bell on your cat’s collar and keeping your cat in at night to help our bird survival rate, especially the smaller species that are already struggling. Also don’t put feeders too near to undergrowth where cats can hide, then pounce, but in a rather more open space. I have mine on feeder poles, which I can move around the garden. This also helps with hygiene issues, preventing the spread of disease among birds.
