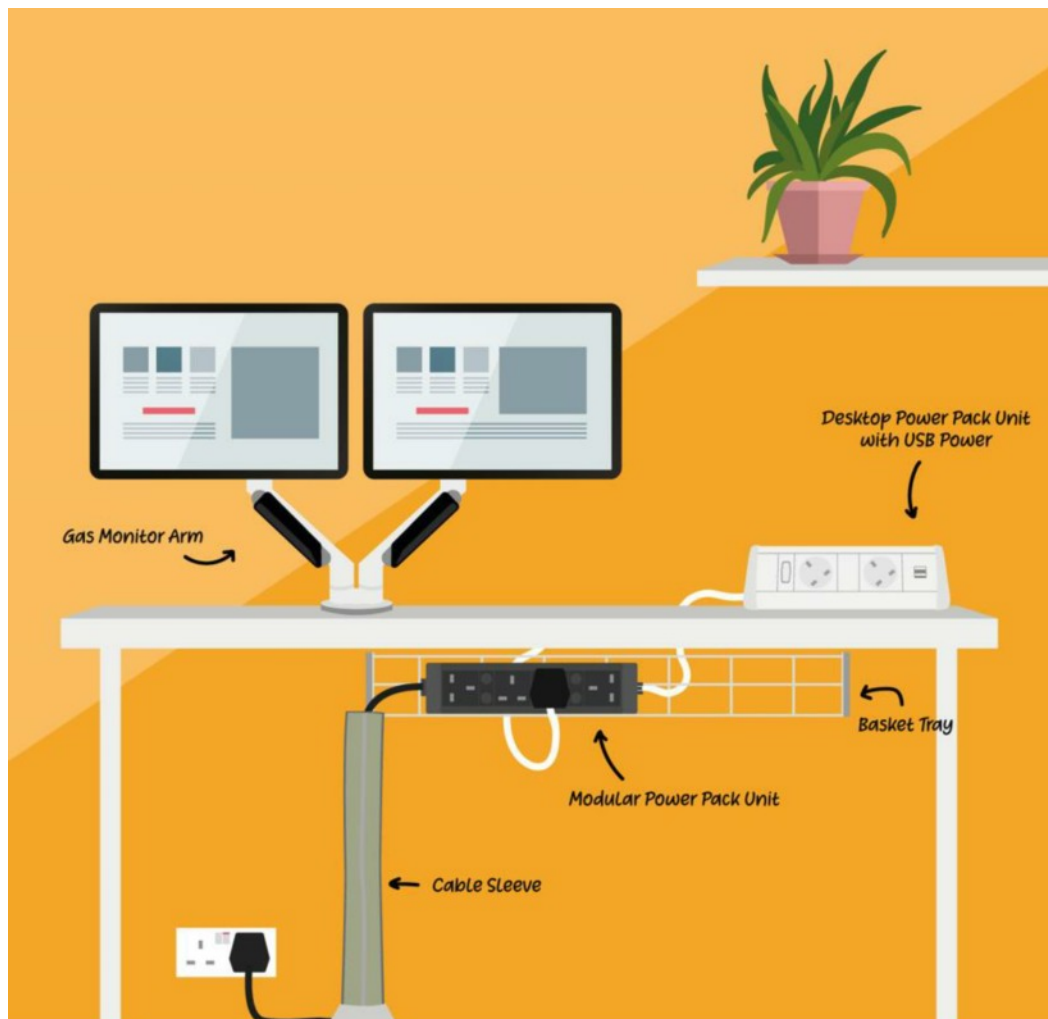

Rector's Letter November 2024



November brings with it a time for remembrance of those who have died in wars and conflicts past and present. For over a century, to honour all those who have served and their families, we are encouraged to buy and wear a poppy.

The poppy was a common sight in the fields on the Western Front during the First World War and the flower provided Canadian doctor John McCrae with inspiration for his poem '*In Flanders Fields*'. In 1918, in response to McCrae's poem, American humanitarian Moina Michael wrote '*And now the Torch and Poppy Red, we wear in honor of our dead...*'. She campaigned to make the poppy a symbol of remembrance of those who had died in the war.

Artificial poppies were first sold in Britain in 1921 to raise money to support ex-servicemen and the families of those who had died in the conflict. Selling poppies proved so popular that in 1922 the British Legion founded a factory - staffed by disabled ex-servicemen - to produce its own. It continues to do so today, with a new plastic free poppy now being made.

Remembrance Sunday this year is on 10th November and there will be services in all three of our villages. At Ecton there will be a service of Holy Communion at 9.30am in church followed by a service of Remembrance at the Shrine at 10.45am. At Wilby a Morning Prayer Service will be held in church at 10am, moving to the war memorial in the churchyard at 10.50am for an Act of Remembrance. There will then be a Remembrance Service at Great Doddington church at 6pm. There will be no morning service at Great Doddington that day.

Poppies and Remembrance services remind us of the sacrifice so many have made for our freedom and how final death can seem. However, the Christian faith teaches us that through the sacrifice of Jesus, death is not the end but a new beginning. May the promise of eternal life, won for us by Jesus through the cross, comfort us all as we remember once again the ultimate sacrifice made by so many for our freedom.
