Rector's Letter October 2025



You may have heard that there is something happening in the Church called The Quiet Revival. The younger generation are rediscovering faith. People are coming to church who have never been before, searching for meaning and stability in a world of crisis and uncertainty.

Last year the Bible Society commissioned a YouGov Poll in which 16% of young adults said they go to church at least once a month; 45% of people in England and Wales now believe there is probably or definitely a God or a higher power and one in four are interested in learning more about the Bible. One way to learn about the Christian faith is to read and study the Bible and Sunday 26th October has been designated by the Church as Bible Sunday. A day set aside to celebrate God's Word.

There are several ways to read the Bible, which is actually made up of 66 books. You can read it from beginning to end; you can start with one of the Gospels, Matthew, Mark, Luke or John, and learn about the life of Jesus or you could choose one of the books that interests you for whatever reason. As well as reading a book or the Bible all the way through, it can be helpful to have a Bible Commentary which can be read alongside the Bible and/or daily Bible reading notes, available as printed or electronic copies. There are many different ones available. We also have a Benefice Study Group and a Lent Course each year.

These are just a few of the ways to read and study the Bible, if you would like more information, please do contact me or come along to one of our services on Sunday 26th October 9.30am at Wilby and 11am Ecton. You will be made most welcome.

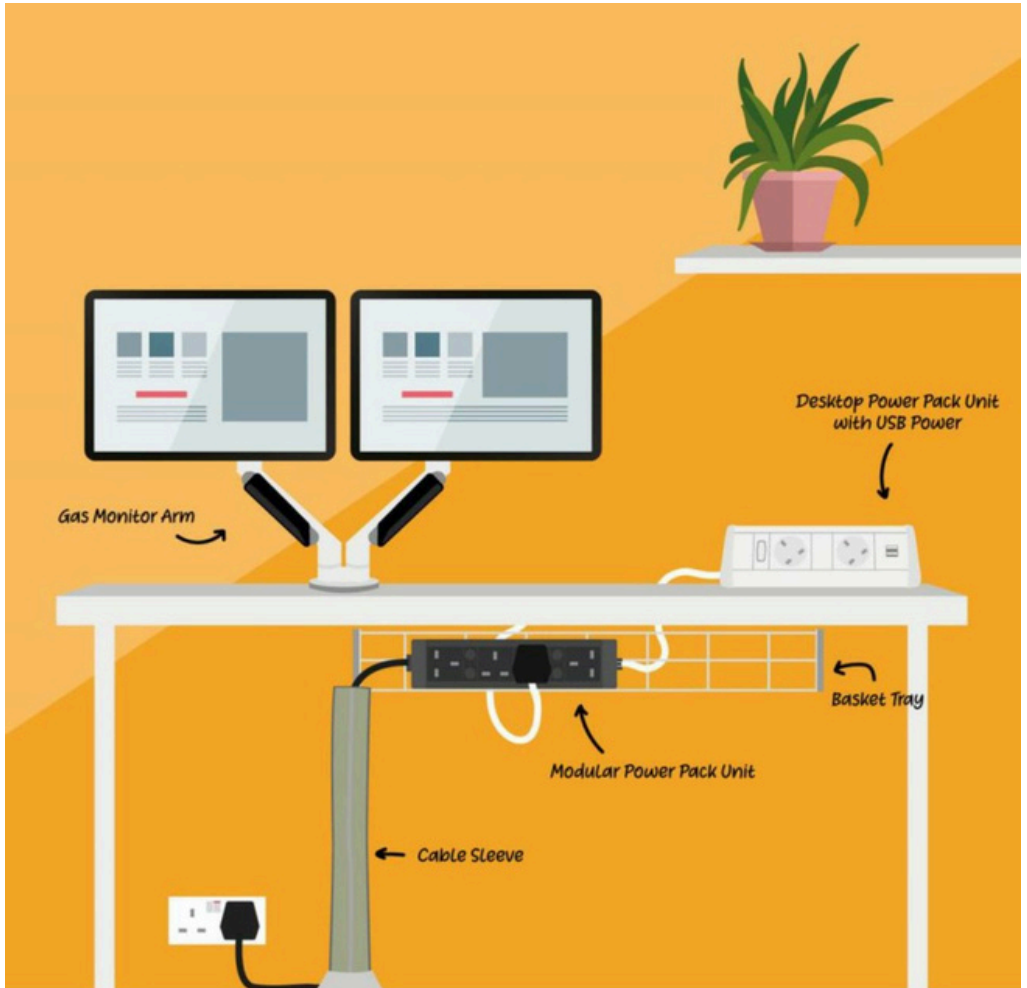

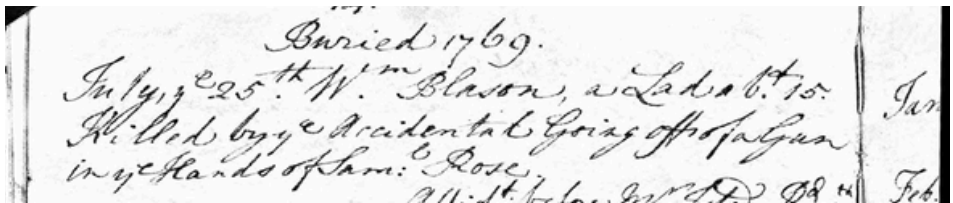

Ecton History

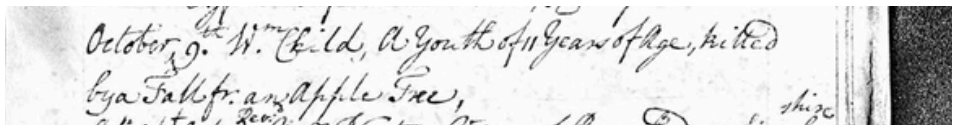
Firstly, thank you to all who came along to our last meeting, we had a fun, informal chat about the history of the village, our memories and those of past family. Some of us brought along old photographic Postcards and photos of Ecton, as well as some old School text books, from the 1800's, some published around the time of the Village School opening in 1877. I will share some of the rich 'Facts' in these old books another time.

In my continued search of the Parish Records, I have come across some more details of past events, written in by the Rector's which escape the usual quick search methods.



"Buried 1769.

July ye 25th, William Blason, a lad about 15,
Killed by ye accidental going off of a Gun
in ye hands of Samuel Rose"



[Buried 1764]

"October 9th, William Child, A youth of 11 years of age, Killed
by a Fall from an Apple Tree"

What Is It That We Do?

Everybody has heard of Scalextric, a toy racing car set, the toy most lads (and some girls) wanted when they were kids.

Well some of us never grew up and we hold large racing events around the country. While the technology has changed immensely over the years the principle is basically the same, toy cars on a plastic track with powered rails.

So, What's Changed?

Digital slot car racing has been around for a good few years now, the original concept of Scalextric only allowed 1 car to drive on each lane of the track, digital racing allows multiple cars to drive on the same lane and at certain points around a circuit the drivers have the option to change lanes to either overtake slower cars or get a better racing line through corners and therefore get a quicker lap time.

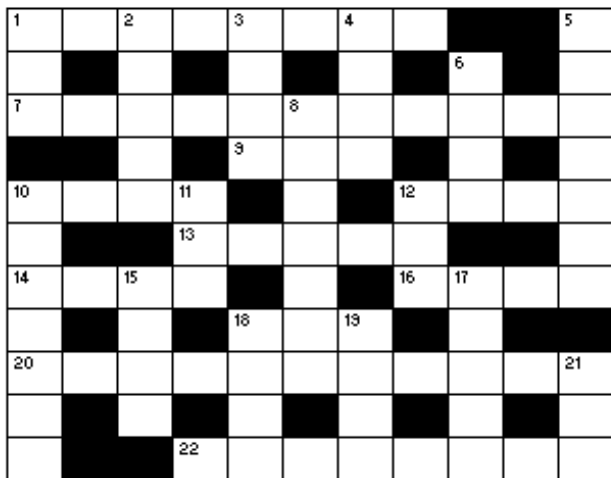

My Friend the Spider

I have to say that I love and admire spiders! I know many people don't like them or have a fear of them, in fact last week I was helping some people collect conkers to put in their homes to deter spiders. There are no venomous spiders in the UK and very few will bite and only if threatened. In fact spiders do a great deal of good as they eat mosquitoes, flies and other creatures that eat our plants and crops and they are food for birds, amphibians and other wildlife, so are a very important part of our ecosystem. Most spiders prefer to live in sheds, garages and under shrubs, although some (house spiders) will come indoors at this time of year, mainly males in search of a mate. So PLEASE, if you can't cope with them living alongside you for a while, carefully put them back outside. There are special "humanitarian" spider catchers available to buy, or a container with a piece of paper/cardboard underneath is equally as good. AND PERHAPS, before you let them go have a look at the beautiful colours and markings on their amazing little bodies.
