The month of September brings us to the start of autumn and harvest time, a time to give thanks to God for his many gifts to us in creation. Here in our three parishes, we are fortunate to be surrounded by fields, producing either valuable crops or grazing for cattle or sheep. To be so close to nature and the rhythm of the seasons is such a blessing and reminds us every day of both the beauty and challenges of our world. Please do spare a thought and prayer this month for all farmers, who do an amazing job in often difficult circumstances.

As part of our thanksgiving for God's creation we will have our traditional Harvest Festival Services as follows:

**St Mary the Virgin, Wilby – Sunday 28th September 9.30am (Holy Communion)**

**St Mary Magdalene, Ecton – Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> September 11am (Morning Prayer)**

**St Nicholas, Great Doddington – Sunday 5th October 11am (Holy Communion)**

At these services we ask for gifts of non-perishable goods to be brought, these will then be given to the Daylight Centre and Food Bank in Wellingborough. The services will be about an hour in length and will include traditional harvest hymns and refreshments afterwards.

On **Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> October 3pm at Ecton church** we have our annual Benefice Memorial Service. A service to remember and give thanks for the lives of those who have died, it is a service for everyone, whether your loss is recent or many years ago. The service will be about 45 minutes and will include hymns, readings, a short address, prayers and the opportunity to light a candle in memory of our loved ones. Refreshments will be served afterwards.

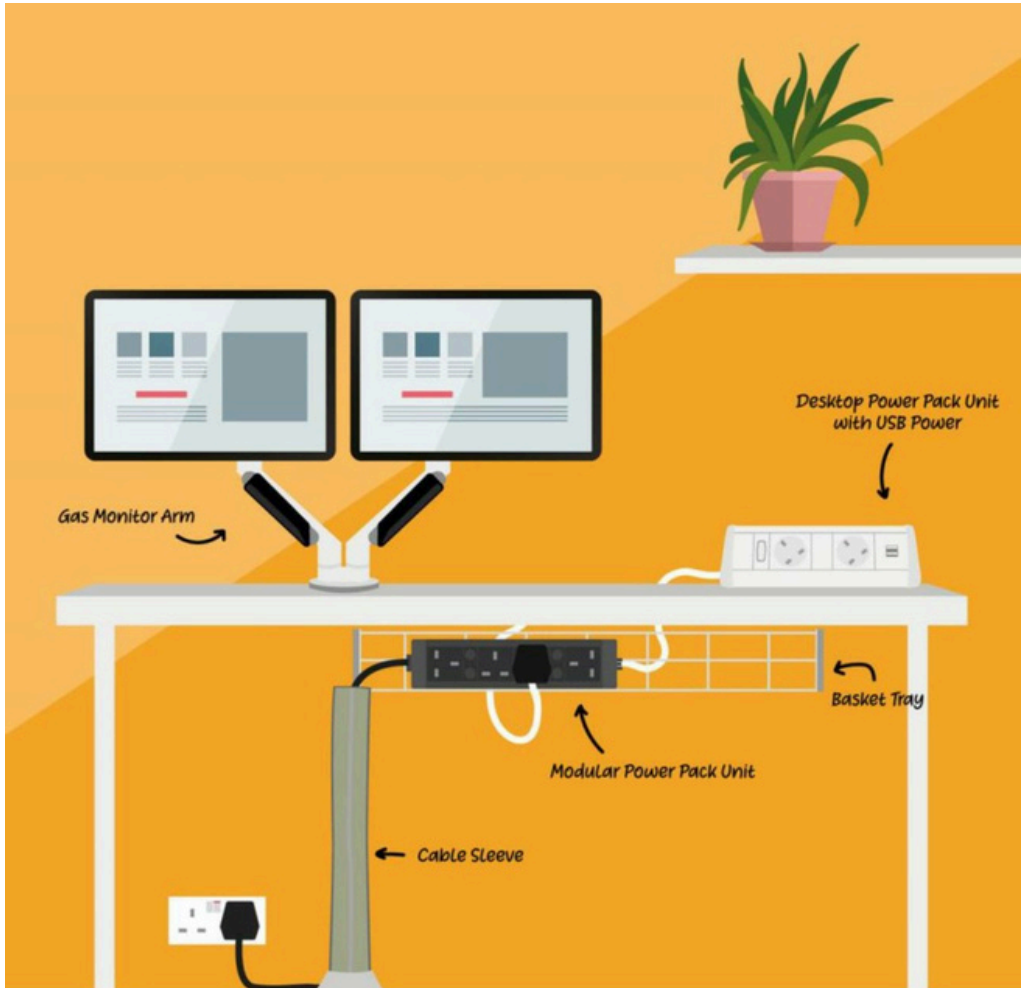

# Ecton History

## John & Martha Van 1736 - 1811

At the beginning of June 2025, when I was helping to tidy the Churchyard with the other volunteers, I came across John Van, his and his Wife's Grave Stones, made of Leicestershire Slate, were both very over grown with Ivy & Brambles, after clearing them I was keen to find out more about John & Martha.

Part of John's Inscription reads - Sacred to the Memory of John Van, Forty years Master of the Free-School of the Parish who departed this life on the 5<sup>th</sup> November 1811, aged 75 years after a lingering illness, which he bore with the most patient fortitude, leaving his Wife and seven Children to lament his loss.

John & Martha were Schoolmaster & Schoolmistress of the School for Poor Children which was built in 1752, they would have also lived there with their 7 Children. - More Research to follow.

Their Daughter Martha was Baptised at Ecton 23<sup>rd</sup> July 1775, I found the entry after a bit of searching on Ancestry as it had been miss-transcribed as - July 23<sup>rd</sup> Martha, Daughter of John Schoolmaster & Martha his Wife.

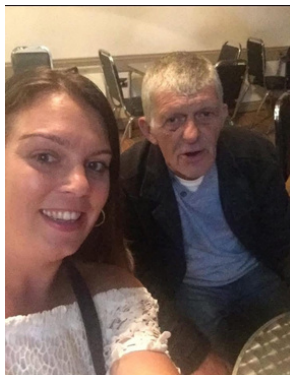
# Community Page

The UK Government will conduct a nationwide test of the Emergency Alerts system at 3pm on Sunday 7 September 2025.

The Emergency Alerts system is designed to warn people of life-threatening situations, such as extreme weather, flooding or fires.

The test is part of the Government's Resilience Action Plan to ensure the system works effectively and that the public is familiar with it. During the test, mobile phones will vibrate and make a loud siren sound for roughly ten seconds, even if they are set to silent. A message will also appear on phone screens, making it clear the alert is only a test.

## Council cracks down on illegal disposal of white goods



Wellingborough Waste Enforcement Team is reminding residents to dispose of white goods - such as fridges, freezers and washing machines - safely and legally.

Items in good condition could be donated to local charities for reuse or taken to your local recycling site for disposal.

You could book a **Bulky Item Collection** via the North Northants website.

· If you choose to use a private waste carrier, always make sure they are registered and ask for a waste transfer note - this document proves your waste was handed over responsibly and legally. Without it, you could be held liable if the items are fly-tipped.

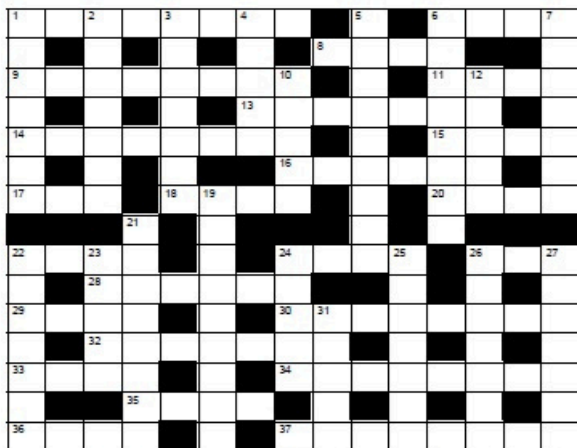
